#### PHELAN'S LOCAL BOARD UPDATE

Work has started on the \$10 million road upgrades that have been funded from Council's Urban Growth Fund to deal with the Huapai Triangle Special Housing Area. These include the Tapu/Station Road realignment creating a new intersection and work around a controlled level crossing on Access Road. It is anticipated that plans with go out to the public around mid year, land procurement next year with a planned completion date of Late 2018.

The Local Board is starting on a Greenways Plan for Huapai, Kumeu and Riverhead, the first consultation meeting will be held from 2-7pm on the 17th May in the Kumeu Arts Centre. If you're interested in what a Greenways Plan looks like here's our recently completed plan for Wellsford google 'Rodney Local Board Wellsford Greenways Plan'.

We will also be starting the long anticipated Kumeu Huapai Centre Plan in May but at the time of writing I do not have a date, keep an eye on the local papers and Facebook Groups for information.

A petition to request NZTA address a range of traffic and safety issues on SH16 is still open. The goal of the petition is to gather over 5000 signatures. To find out more about the petition and sign it visit: https://www.change.org/p/nzta-fix-state-highway-16

Auckland Transport has acknowledged that rail services are the number one priority from recent public feedback from residents and they have given an undertaking that they are looking at battery powered trains for a new western service. The Public Transport Users Association has an ongoing petition supporting rail services to Huapai and supporting this will help keep pressure on AT to keep it's word on rail. #### **WAIMAUKU GALA**


The Gala and market day in Waimauku on Sunday 3 April was a great suc-

# SAFER COMMUNITIES

Fleeing driver incidents must end - A stolen Mazda was seen by police on Waimumu Road, Massey. Police followed the vehicle for a short time then stopped alongside it at an intersection where they signalling the driver to pull over. The driver initially indicted that they would comply, but then drove off at speed along Central Park Drive. Police activated lights and sirens and a pursuit was initiated. The vehicle passed Te Pai Place, travelled over the bridge spanning Henderson Creek along Central Park Drive. After the bridge the driver lost control of the vehicle, veering over the footpath on the left side of the road. The vehicle proceeded up the bank and skidded along the grass coming to rest against a nearby tree. The driver's side took the full impact. The driver was initially trapped in the vehicle which caught fire. Officers used fire extinguishers to stop the fire whilst other officers extracted the driver from the car. The driver was taken to hospital with serious injuries, while three police officers were assessed by ambulance staff at the scene for the effects of smoke inhalation. The driver, a 15-year-old male spent significant time in Auckland Hospital. Acting Area Commander Inspector Claire Humble says this is another example of the tragic consequences which can occur if a driver fails to comply with a simple instruction by police to stop.. "Once again we must give the message that if you are told to stop by police, then just pull over and get the matter sorted out. The consequences of not doing so can lead to a devastating outcome, as we saw" said Inspector Humble.

Over the third weekend in April the members of the Waitakere Fire Brigade undertook portable pump training with the Civil Defence and Emergency Management West Auckland Response Team. The training was for them to up skill in the use of portable pumps so that they could assist at large vegetation fires and flood conditions such as flooded houses.

Training took place in a variety of locations including creeks, ponds and portable dams. The heavy on the Sunday made the training challenging and realistic. All members of both teams did a fantastic job and it is great to see professional volunteer units working collaboratively to benefit the community.

Worn and old electric blankets can cause electric shock, fire and possibly even death. Have your electric blanket tested annually by a qualified electrician. Turn off the electric blanket power when you get into bed. Do not place heavy objects on the bed while the electric blanket is turned on. Ensure electric blanket controls are not twisted or caught between the mattress and base. Make sure the electric blanket is tightly secured and laid flat on the bed. When not in use, store your electric blanket rolled up, NOT folded. Electric blankets are not recommended for use by babies or young children as "bed-wetting" may occur The Waitakere Brigade was present at both Swanson and Waitakere RSA's and it was an honour for us to be involved. This is a very important day for New Zealand and Australia and I hope you made time to reflect on the sacrifices made by our service men and women. Lest we forget.







an income for life. However, New Zealand legislation coming into force on 1st December 2016 will restrict withdrawals significantly, only allowing less than 10% in total to be paid at this age. Therefore, if you wish to take advantage of the current legislation, it is imperative that your pension transfer is well underway before 30th November. #### **15 MIN CHOCOLATE SQUARES**

Base:

1 ¾ Tbsp Cocoa ½ tsp Baking Powder

1 cup Flour

Pinch salt

1 cup cornflakes

1 cup coconut

34 cup sugar

150 gms butter

Chocolate icing:

2 ½ cups Icing sugar

2 Tbsp melted Butter

Approx 2 Tbsp hot water

1 tsp vanilla essence Combine all together and add enough water to make a thick spreadable consistency. Melt the butter and set aside. Combine all the other dry ingredients together then stir in the melted

butter until well combined. Press into the base of a shallow tin. Bake at 180 for 10-12 mins. Remove from oven and while it is still hot cut into squares and spread chocolate icing over the entire top. The icing will soak in and make the slice more 'fudgey'. Leave to cool and set and then drizzle with melted chocolate or

sprinkle with coconut.

#### **SASHIMI RECIPE**

Do you know you can buy sashimi-grade fish from Ocean Seafood in Silverdale? Simply give them a call and ask for stock available. For this recipe, do not pre-slice the fish; bring a whole chunk home and start from there. Instead of pan-fried, this recipe uses just boiling water to make it healthier.



**Ingredients** 

Sashimi-grade tuna 500g in one piece

Chopped spring onion

Sauce

1 tablespoon lime/lemon juice

2 tablespoon soy sauce

1 tablespoon tsuyu (available in Countdown)

1 teaspoon mirin (again, available in Countdown)



To make

- 1. Cut the tuna into a few long rectangular piece, approximately 3 x 6 x 15cm, depending on the size of your fish
- 2. Put the fish into a deep bowl or saucepan, pour in hot boiled water. Use chopsticks to quickly turn the fish over to ensure all sides are well covered and turn "white"
- 3. Immediately soak the fish into cold water to avoid "over-cooking"
- 4. Carefully slice it into around 1cm thick and it's ready to serve with the sauce!



Reactivity, what is it? While it comes in many different forms, reactivity is a common behaviour problem that many people encounter at some point in their dogs' lives. Simply put, reactivity can be defined as an overreaction to external stimuli. Dogs may be reactive to people, dogs, other animals, noises, motion, or any combination of the above. Some dogs are very specifically reactive, only responding to certain things (men with baseball caps; large, black dogs; skateboards) while some seem to react to anything. This overreaction can manifest as hyper excitability, barking, whining, lunging, mouthing, pacing, panting, difficulty responding to well-known cues, difficulty calming down, hypervigilance, or any combination of the above.

Hydrotherapy exercise is demanding on the dog's cardiovascular system and is therefore not suitable for dogs with heart conditions. Swimming requires four times as much effort as land-based exercise, so a five minute swim is equivalent to a 20 minute brisk walk. ### ATTRACTING BIRDS TO YOUR GARDEN

Many a gardener is a nature lover as well, and one of life's pleasures is see-



ing your garden provide food and shelter for native wildlife year round.

Whether you have a large garden or small, there are plenty of plants to attract and feed the birds especially during winter and spring when birds such as Tuis and our native wood pigeon will travel long distances in search of food. Food sources are scarce during the winter, so even if you planted a couple of different varieties of plants for the birds, and your neighbour planted a couple more, soon you will have birds visiting throughout the year.

For now, here are a few tricks to getting the most out of your paint scheme.

Test your colour before painting the whole room. Trust me! Grab a test pot and on a large A2 sheet of card, paint two coats, leaving a 2cm border around the edge. Place this card in different areas of the house (north and south facing) and examine it during the day and night.

Paint the ceiling a colour. Yes, that's right, out with the old boring white ceiling and

in with the bold and beautiful! Add a feature pendant light and watch the mood of your room completely change.
Use some of this season's elegant but

bold colours; burnt orange, grape purple, deep green, teal and mustard yellow. Experiment, it's fun and easy! If you need more persuasion, have a peruse through Pinterest and score some yummy ideas. Natural and artificial lighting have an enormous effect on the paint colour. The same colour will look different depending on the orientation of the space; north facing rooms tend to make colours look warmer while south facing rooms make colours look cooler.

Likewise with artificial lighting; a cool LED will keep your bright whites fresh (great for a white bathroom) while a warm LED will make your paint colour look warmer and whites creamier. There's a whole raft of tricks when it comes to paint and lighting!

If you're going dark, consider using a multi-pigmented paint in a flat or low sheen. This will give you a great perception of depth; walls that will draw you in and hug you rather than slap you in the face. Using a flat finish will help disguise surface imperfections.

However, I still recommend a level 5 plasterboard finish. Finally, make sure you nail your lighting. Have plenty and dimmable so you can control the mood.

Get your colour strength right. If you'd like your ceiling to be the same colour as your skirting and/or walls, then make your ceiling 1-2 shades lighter. Ceilings receive less light so will always appear darker.

Decorating is all about taking risks. Even the pro's get it wrong from time to time. If you make a mistake, just take a step back, put your detective hat on and ask yourself what the missing link is, what's not quite working? Then tweak until voila! Magic happens!

### **FACIAL ECZEMA - PART THREE**

#### LONG TERM SOLUTIONS

- Replacing affected pastures with improved ryegrass cultivars or other species that won't support the fungus is a good longterm prevention strategy. Check with your seed merchant for the latest information.
- FE resistance in sheep is strongly inherited so buying rams from breeders who are selecting for resistance will bring about improvement in your flock.
- Check with the breeder about the level of sporidesmin used in their tests and the length of time they've been testing.
- Consult your veterinarian on the merits of GGT testing to select replacement ewe hoggets. It may be cost-effective on some farms.
- Gene markers for FE resistance have been found and are being actively researched in both cattle and sheep.
- FE resistance is known to be inherited in dairy cattle and research is ongoing.
- Work on deer and camelids is yet to be done.
- Other solutions such as altering the infective fungus are still being researched.

### TREATMENT OF AFFECTED ANIMALS Sheep

- Sheep with clinical FE must be treated under the law so seek veterinary help. Severe cases will have to be euthanased.
- At the first signs of FE, provide shade and drench with zinc oxide. Shade is critical. It may be too late for the zinc oxide to do much good.
- Opaque protective cream can be applied to damaged skin, to hasten healing and to screen the skin from sunlight.
- Put badly affected sheep with swollen eyelids and poor vision in a safe paddock and avoid the stress of handling.

- For small flocks, put them in a shed out of the sun during the day and let them out to graze at night,
- Affected sheep need good feeding to help recover, but feed them some high energy concentrates rather than high protein lush green grass which their livers cannot handle. Cattle
- At the first signs of FE, affected animals should be given shade and drenched with oxide. Shade is critical. It may be too late for the zinc oxide to do much good.
- Take them off the 'hot' pasture either to a bare area to feed supplements or to some other safe part of the farm.
- Opaque protective cream can be applied to damaged skin, to hasten healing and to screen the skin from sunlight.
- Your veterinarian can give antibiotic injections to treat skin infections that occur if animals are severely affected and vitamin B12 injections can help to boost appetite.
- Severely affected dairy cows with areas of sloughed skin should be fitted with a cover provided it does not chafe and add to their suffering. Dry off dairy cows with severe signs, especially those with udder and teat damage. Flies can be serious irritants.

#### MONITORING

- Spore numbers are measured by collecting a sample of pasture and shaking it up in a jar of water. A sample of the liquid is inspected in a special slide under a microscope to count the spores. Check with your veterinarian for details.
- Kits are available to do this at home, or veterinary clinics provide a service
- The best idea is to sample specific "monitoring" paddocks e.g. shaded sheltered areas where spores are likely to grow. This is better than just random sampling paddocks on the farm.
- You can find out about current spore levels at veterinary clinics, in local newspapers. Beware of local rumours. They may not be relevant to your farm, especially when they say the danger is low!

It took 30 years of dedicated research at Ruakura Research Centre in Hamilton to work all this out, but prevention methods have been known now for 40 years.
