Strawberries are a Kumeu winner



As urban sprawl forces traditional strawberry growing areas away, it is comforting to find the Kumeu and surrounding districts embracing strawberry growing operations which typically have a mix of high value export and national grocery chain cropping mixed with local services which include gate sales, real fruit ice creams and later in the year the famous Kiwi 'pick your own' season. Strawberry growing operations in the area pull in thousands of migrant workers for picking and packing along

with Tourism demand that registers a direct growth in visitor numbers in the area. New retailers are taking advantage of this growth, opening new retail stores on State Highway 16.

Huapai north zoning – all go

Finally the zoning for the Huapai North area has been decided upon by the Environment Court on the 5th November. The original zoning and rules were subject to three appeals by developers and one land owner. The Judge criticised the over prescription rules created by the old Rodney District Council. The areas for section being decided on for the medium density provisions were min 600m, max 900m with an averaging provision of 700m. This meets what the Association proposed at the Council hearings. The next effect will be approximately 1200 additional sections being created in the area over the next 5 years. I would expect the bulldozers will start work this summer, to ensure a final build will be available before the end of April 2014. This increase in zoning will have a flow on effect on Kumeu-Huapai Township with local shops hopefully benefiting with the growth. An interesting consequence of the zoning will be the increase in numbers of school children attending. Huapai School. At present the school is at capacity with just under 480 children attending. With the new zoning a consequential growth in numbers of about 350 will occur. The school has limited space for additional classrooms and may have to consider 'building up'.cont on page 4

Wishing you all a safe and Merry Christmas from us all at Kumeu Volunteer Fire Brigade! We thank you all for your support throughout the year. Wives, husbands, partners, kids, family, friends, our businesses, work colleagues, team mates, and anyone else we have had to up and leave at the sound of the siren - thanks for your support. We can't do it without the support you give us. The festive season is fast approaching us as it does every year. As adults, if we can remember back as far as kids it took forever from the last day of school to the big day the guy in the big red suit arrived. So before you put your feet up for the year you can help us out with a few checks.

BBQ fires can be caused by too much fat collected in the fat tray - so replace with new absorbent (kitty litter does the trick). Turn your bottle on and run soapy water over the hoses and fittings; this will expose any leaks in worn 'o' rings at the bottle end or leaks in the hoses. Also check that your garden hose works and is able to reach to your BBQ, if in doubt call the fire brigade before things get out of control.

Sensored Outdoor Security just a quick check that they are not staying on for long periods or are left on 24/7 as they do generate a lot of heat sheltered under eaves. Save the hassle of those old Christmas lights not all working and sparkle up your house with some new safer LED lights. Be careful not to overload your multipoint power boxes though.

Is the poo getting through? Last month we gave Watercare services the opportunity to come clean re-

Last month we gave Watercare services the opportunity to come clean regarding whispers that came forward about the lack of a complete and a cohesive solution to Kumeu and Riverheads town poo solution. Comments made from Watercare indicated that the waste collection being done from Riverhead was a separate issue and that within the next month or two trucks would not be required. We understand that this is a complete load of cr_p and that Watercare services is in serious doo doos. The pump station that links with the Kumeu Riverhead scheme is behind by as much as eight months according to some insiders within Watercare Services and that the system could potentially suffer a constipation should the night-cart trucks fail to upload the system. Allegations that the system was not project managed properly, was



behind schedule and is insufficient to cope with the future growth in population in Kumeu and Riverhead seems to be falling on deaf ears. Furthermore it is suggested that you don't discard your septic tank just yet, in case you need a plan B. We would welcome Watercare to deliver a more balanced view of the project in future rather than a lip gloss.

The Education Board have no money for growth but acknowledge children numbers won't stay static as they have over the last few years, but grow over the next 1-4 years. A simple solution would be to acquire or designate rural land adjoining the school to plan for the schools growth. I hope common sense prevails and some prudent planning is done early. The 'I Site' in Kumeu is to close in December after Ateed (Auckland Tourism & Events) have managed it for just over 12 months. The site earns little revenue and under Ateed's management the voluntary workers were replaced by paid staff. The nett result is an 'I Site' which is uneconomic in their eyes, hence the closure. What wasn't factored in the decision was the lost benefits to the Wineries, Restaurants, Cafes and special interest groups in our district. There isn't a solution yet but Tony Soljan and I are working on a new proposal with Atteed. Certainly the District will have to step up to help solve the problem, otherwise a valuable community service will be lost. Our Christmas function will be at 'Soljans Restaurant' on Wednesday the 5th December. We will have Westgate Development proposals presented to us so we can all see the extent of what is now at earthwork stage. Westgate being 5 minutes drive from Kumeu will have an impact on how we develop our commercial & industrial area in the future. Your blood could save a life



Ask Madie King when her life changed forever and she will quickly rattle off September 8, 2010. That was the day the 11-year-old found out she had precursor b-cell lymphoblastic lymphoma - a complicated-sounding cancer diagnosis which started as a lump in her neck. She had just finished a netball tournament when she told her mother, Mary-Lee Rolleston-King, "I've got a lump". What followed were numerous trips to the doctor, biopsies and surgeries. "We found out she had cancer, but they were not too sure what sort," Mrs Rolleston-King said. She was soon in Christchurch, with her family, for seven and a-half weeks of chemotherapy and the years of treatment began. Madie regularly receives intramuscular and intrathecal (spinal) chemotherapy injections, blood and platelet transfusions and a "huge amount" of other drugs via a port in her side. She has more than 400 beads of courage and several years of treatment. One of the most memorable of them so far was an emergency blood transfusion on Christmas Eve. "As soon as she had it, her wee cheeks just went lovely and rosy and red. For us, that gave Madie some cheer and joy to get through Christmas," Mrs Rolleston-King said.

The New Zealand Blood Service will be holding a blood drive in Kumeu on Monday 10th December 2012, from 12.00pm – 6pm at the Community Centre on Access Road. If you would like to help save a life, please call 0800 448 325 for an appointment, or just walk in on the day.

Hospice lights up for Christmas



Festive chocolate clusters

This is an old family favourite. I have been baking these for many years and they always go down a treat. The recipe actually calls for dark chocolate to be spread on the bottom of each cluster when cool but I prefer to top with white chocolate and a glace cherry, they taste great and look much more festive!

It's not too late to order your Christmas cakes. They come beautifully packaged, ready for gifting – check them out on my facebook page; I had a table of them at the Waimauku Kindy Ladies Night.

3/4 cup sultanas 1 c cornflakes 1/2 c flaked almonds

3/4 c shredded coconut 1/4 c glace cherries halved

1/2 c Dark Choc Bits (I prefer milk choc and I increase the amount to 3/4 c)

3/4 c Highlander Sweetened Condensed Milk

White choc melts – to drizzle on top

Preheat the oven to 160 degrees Celsius. Line an oven tray with baking paper. Place all the ingredients except the white choc melts in a large bowl. Mix well. Place teaspoonful of the mixture onto the tray (make sure that the mixture is compact and not spread out as it

will spread a little while baking). Bake in a pre-heated oven for 12-15 minutes or until golden brown (in my oven it usually takes 10 minutes, so watch them!). Leave on the tray until cool, then place on a rack. 
